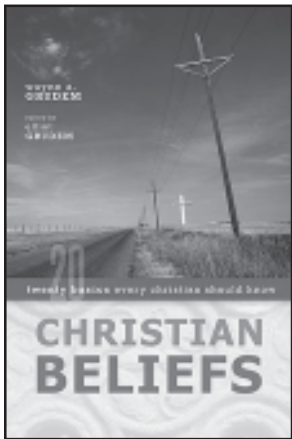

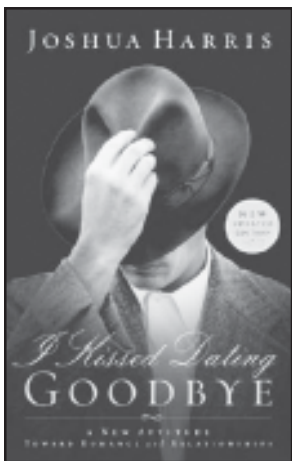


Christian Beliefs: Twenty Basics Every Christian Should Know By Wayne & Elliot Grudem

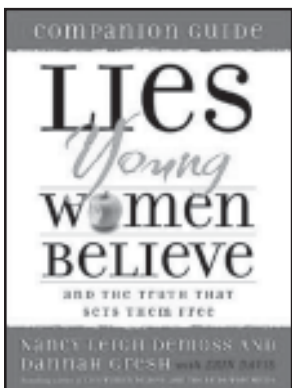

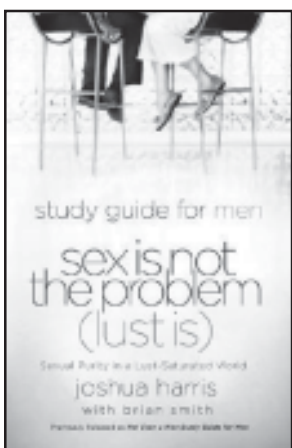
