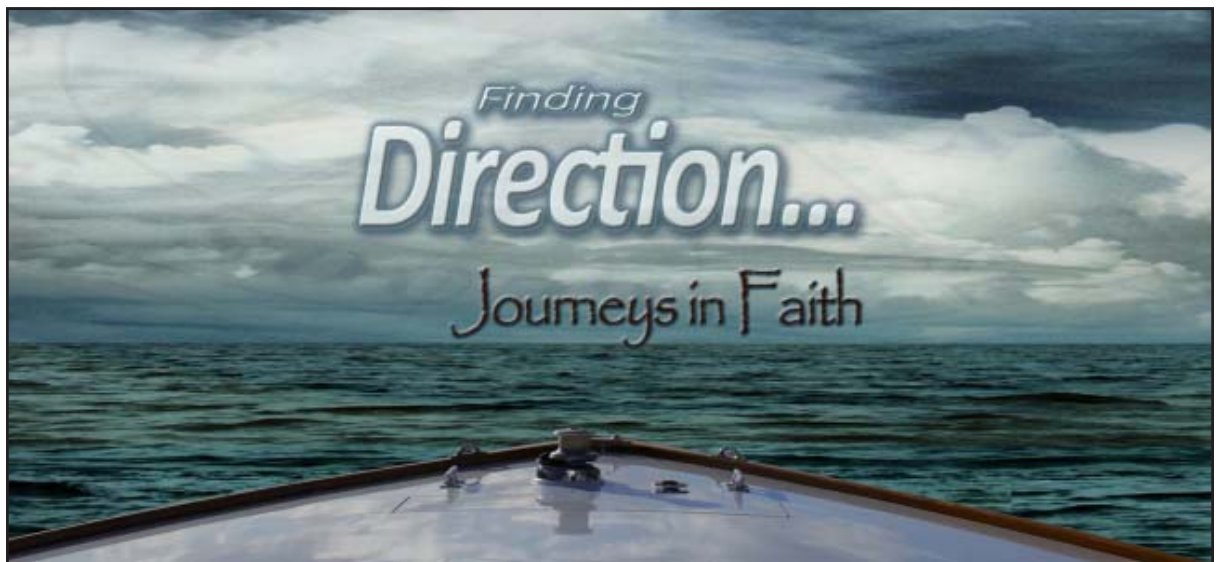

Remember Well

We are stepping into a new day of student ministry at Severns Valley. So much is on the horizon and so much potential to be reached. Isaiah 43:18-19, "Remember not the former things, nor consider the things of old. Behold I am doing a new thing..."

These verses are both exciting and confusing at the same time. They are exciting because God is speaking to His people about doing new things among them and confusing because God is telling His people not to remember anything that has ever happened before. To make matters more confusing, only three chapters later in Isaiah 46 God commands his people to "Remember...and stand firm (8-10)." On one hand we are to forget and on the other we are to remember. So, which is it? When do we do one and not the other? The answers come from looking at the context of these two verses. God is teaching His people there are two ways of remembering. There is one way that binds you to the past like chains on your ankles, keeping you from walking in the significance of the present and the hope of the future. It is the kind of remember-

ing God warns His people about in Isaiah 43 when he says, "Remember not...forget." There is another way to remember—to think on the past that can stir us, inspire us, motivate us, and cause of to be flexible and trusting in the present, seeking to live to the fullest in all that is to come. This is the good kind of remembering God commands of his people in Isaiah 46, to remember all He has

done and who He has shown himself to be in the past, setting us free to follow Him with reckless abandon as we step into the future.

It is our aim to step into all of the new things that God desires to accomplish among us by celebrating the past and positioning ourselves for radical obedience for all that is ahead. May we be marked as people who remember well.

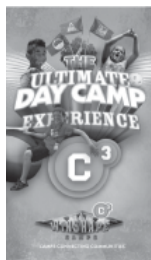
